

Year 1 Autumn Term Newsletter

We hope this newsletter gives you an overview of our learning and provides you with some ideas for how best to support your child at home.

English

During English lessons the children will focus on the stories 'Lost and Found' and 'Nibbles the Book Monster'.

We ask that you don't read ahead, as we read the story over a few weeks, learning and writing about it as we go. Our Writing Mastery Keys are:

- **Combine words to make sentences**
- Leave spaces between words
- Begin to use capital letters and full stops
- Use capital letters for names of people and the personal pronoun 'I'

We have started our new Read Write Inc Phonics books this term. Please continue to read the RWI books sent home (which are at an assessed level) but also any other books for pleasure. We think the key to good reading and writing is to enjoy reading (to a grown-up, sibling, or even the cat) and to enjoy being read to.

The children will be given a two RWI books each Friday. One of the stories the children will have practiced in school so should be read fluently and the other is a new reading book. Both books should to be returned the following Friday. Please ensure all books are returned promptly so we can give your child their next book, new books will not be sent out until others are returned.


R.E

Maths

During Maths lessons we will be building upon the children's EYFS learning. The children will be developing their mathematic skills through guided activities with adults in class. They will also be accessing Maths challenges through continuous provision (maths learning through play).

Our units for this term are:

- Place Value within 10
- Addition and Subtraction within 10
- Geometry Shape
- Place Value within 20

In Science, our focus will be animals, including humans. We will be learning how to group them and about their different characteristics.
