Here is some information about our learning this term.

In English, we will be reading a story called 'The Lost Happy Endings' and using this to inspire our writing. We will produce a traditional tale of our own. After half term we will share 'Queen of the Falls' and produce diary recounts inspired by this remarkable tale.

To support your child with their English learning you could:

- Read and compare different versions of fairy tales (Hansel and Gretel by Neil Gaiman, or Anthony Browne, 'The true story of the three little pigs' Jon Scieszka and Roald Dahl's 'Revolting rhymes')
- Read examples of diaries written by characters, famous people and historical figures found through internet searches
- •Learn more about the grammar we cover (expanded noun phrases, subordinating conjunctions, apostrophes, adverbials and speech punctuation) through education websites

Spellings will be taught weekly and we will focus on a particular sound, pattern or rule. During our Music we will focus on the genre of pop rock. You may like to do some research and listen to the music of bands such as Guns N Rose, Aerosmith and Bon Jovi. In French lessons the children will be focusing on 'Le Corps' and reinforcing their knowledge of parts of the face and body. In Maths we will cover the following skills and topic

Look for examples of graphs and charts in newspapers or news reports or information leaflets. Engage in Maths practically through time telling, calculating with money or measuring when baking. Help children to see that Maths is part of real life.

In D&T this term we will be exploring food, looking at seasonality, where food comes from and the times of year it is available. This will lead us towards designing our own seasonal dish.

Year 5



Science this term focuses on forces. We will explore the force of gravity acting on a falling object. We will investigate air resistance and friction, between moving surfaces also. We will look at making some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears. You could explore gears whilst riding your bike- how do the gears change the way the pedals feel? Which gear is best for uphill cycling? Which gear makes cycling easier? We will discover which materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and decide how mixtures might be separated. In RE lessons this term we will learn all about the Bible and sacred books from other Faiths. You could ask nicely to be given a children's bible to spend time with at home. You could research other faiths, their stories, beliefs and customs. In the weeks leading up to Christmas we will be comparing the nativity story in the Gospels of Matthew & Luke.
