During Maths lessons, children will be continuing to develop and deepen their understanding of number, with a focus on fractions, percentages, decimals, algebra and moving onto units of measure. After half term, we will focus on perimeter, area, ratio and proportion, as well as revising our understanding of place value and written methods.

During RE lessons this term, the children will learn all about the festival of Passover and its significance for Jews. They will also be learning about Eucharist.

Computing

The children will be continuing to write code this term, using a variety of online programs, including Scratch and Microbit; these are available online for children to explore away from the classroom. We will also be creating a short advert using our ipads and Imovies.

English - Reading, Writing and SPAG

During the first half of this term, our English topic is classic fiction, based on books around the theme of giants. Children will be writing descriptions of scenes and character, poetry, letters and an extended story, After the half term break we will be following an Island theme, writing newspaper articles, persuasive reports and diary

In reading, we will develop our comprehension skills and look at inferred meaning, drawing on evidence across the text. We will do this using Reading Plus, class texts and small group reading. We will also develop the children's understanding and application of ambitious vocabulary. Spelling, vocabulary and grammar will be a key focus, as this will support the children's development in their writing.

Reading Plus a reading resource we have subscribed to, enabling the children to access reading and vocabulary tasks beyond the classroom. It is recommended that the children complete 2 of these tasks at home each week.
